## **Face Masks for Health Care Workers**

Help sew N95 Facemask Covers for health care workers.



Attached is a sample pattern and instructions to use if you would like. Note: Cut fabric at least ¼ inch larger than the pattern as the seam allowance is not included in the pattern.

It is best to use a different fabric on the face side than on the outside of the mask to identify which direction it should be worn.

Sew the outside fabric right sides together with interfacing on the back side along the curved edge.

Sew the inside fabric right sides together along the curved edge.

Pin the right sides of front and back panels together, pining the elastic in the corners of the mask on the inside.

Sew around the sides and top of the mask; leaving the entire bottom open. Make sure to sew extra stitches on the elastic.

Flip the mask right side out and press.

Fold in the bottom edges in and top stitch to close continuing around the entire mask.
